- a. Reliance Strategic Business Ventures Limited (RSBVL), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, has today acquired 49% shareholding in Oval Invincibles Limited (Oval Invincibles) from England and Wales Cricked Board (ECB), for an aggregate consideration of GBP 60,270,000.
- b. Oval Invincibles was incorporated in England and Wales on May 10, 2019. The turnover of Oval Invincibles for the year ended January 31, 2025, January 31, 2024, and January 31, 2023 was GBP 2,331,613, GBP 2,102,249 and GBP 2,125,194, respectively.
- c. The investment is not a related party transaction and none of the Company’s promoter / promoter group / other group companies have any interest in the above transaction.
- d. No governmental or regulatory approvals were required for the above transaction.

With this addition, the MI Family now comprises seven teams across five countries and four continents, reflecting MI's vision to grow the game globally, nurture emerging talent, and unite fans through the joy of cricket.
